Convoy to Canberra

Griffith Business Chamber has jumped on board to support a number of organisations coordinating the "Convoy to Canberra" on Monday 2nd December 2019 by footing the bill to send a bus load of people wishing to attend the rally.

"We'll be running a free day-trip bus on Monday 2nd December 2019 for anyone wanting to attend the rally in Canberra and will return the same day.
